The three W's (Who, Where, What)

Aim: To learn about the backgrounds and competences of other junior researchers in CSGB II Format: Each participant will prepare ONE slide (powerpoint or pdf) with information about the three W's.

The text on the slide should be in note form and not a coherent description.

Duration: 3-4 minutes/participant

Who (are you)?

- 1. Name and email
- 2. Field (mathematics, statistics, biology...)
- 3. Position (MA, PhD (and type 3+5; 4+4; 5+3; other), postdoc)

Please include a photo

Where (do you come from - professionally)?

- 1. What is your background (BA+MA) + where do/did you go to university
- 2. where do you work now (your group affiliation in CSGB)
- 3. what is the working title of your project

For point three, you should briefly (~ 1 min) explain the aim of your project in an understandable language (i.e. avoid technical terminology wherever possible). This is done without visual aids (if you feel like drawing something it is okay)

What (are you good at)?

Three keywords describing your competences

You do not need to be experts. It just has to be some things you know about (maybe you took a course about point processes during your MA, you know about image processing, you have experience with complicated statistical analyses etc.)

This is for the benefit of the other junior researchers, ideas for collaborations, informal help etc. If the keywords are not commonly known, a small subheading should be given but this should be in general language (DK: lægmandssprog)

I kindly ask you to prepare the slide answering the things above and bring it with you to the 14th internal CSGB workshop next week.

Please give the slide to me on the first day of the workshop. Then I will combine them to a presentation. During the meeting, we will take turns presenting our slides (we can remain seated, while we do it).
